Why a campaign?

Changing Views will continue the museum's tradition of evolving to achieve excellence, creating a New Amon Carter through preservation, renovation and access.

Why is this important?

To preserve our legacy and create a new layout to elevate the art experience that enriches lives with a fresh interpretation of our prestigious collection.

How much are you trying to raise and by when?

Our fundraising goal for this campaign is to raise \$9M by May 2019. \$4M Preservation; \$4M Renovation; \$1M Accessibility. We have reached over 75% of our fundraising goal.

What will you be changing?

Preservation: Expanded photography cold storage vault and replacing vault mechanicals. **Renovation:** Replacing flooring, walls, lighting, and air circulation systems throughout the galleries; updating building-wide climate systems; adding retractable window shades to the main entrance. **Access:** Design and construct earthen ramps that provide wheelchair access to the Amon Carter's plaza and front entrance.

How will the visitor experience change?

Renovating the galleries for the first time since our 2001 building expansion will situate the collection and exhibitions in a beautiful, more comfortable setting. By undertaking a major reconfiguration, the Amon Carter gains the opportunity to incorporate new acquisitions, respond to contemporary issues and new research in art history, and bring forth creative connections between different works in the collection.

What happens to the museum during construction?

The 2nd floor gallery spaces will be closed during the renovation process. The entirety of the museum will be closed from June 2019 through the reopening activities of September 2019.

Are naming opportunities available?

Naming opportunities are not available for the *Changing Views* campaign.

Will I be able to make a gift over time?

Yes. The museum accepts 1 – 3 year pledge payments to fit with donor's philanthropic giving plans.
